2010 Calligraphy Conference Young Adult Scholarship Application

Odyssey 2010 is pleased to offer scholarship assistance to attend the 30th International Gathering of Lettering Artists. Scholarship assistance covers 30 hours of instruction in either one week-long class or two two-and-a half day classes, 7 nights' dormitory accommodations in a shared room, all meals, class fees, all evening programs, and a supplies stipend of \$100 to be redeemed at the two conference stores, Paper & Ink Arts and John Neal Bookseller. Transportation to and from the conference is not provided. This scholarship is granted based on financial need and merit.

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be 18 years or older by 7/01/10
- Applicant must be a student enrolled in an arts-related program
- Applicant must submit all required materials in triplicate in one package postmarked by February 1st, 2010

- Write a statement about yourself
- Submit two 8 1/2 x 11" printed photographs of your original artwork completed within the past two years
